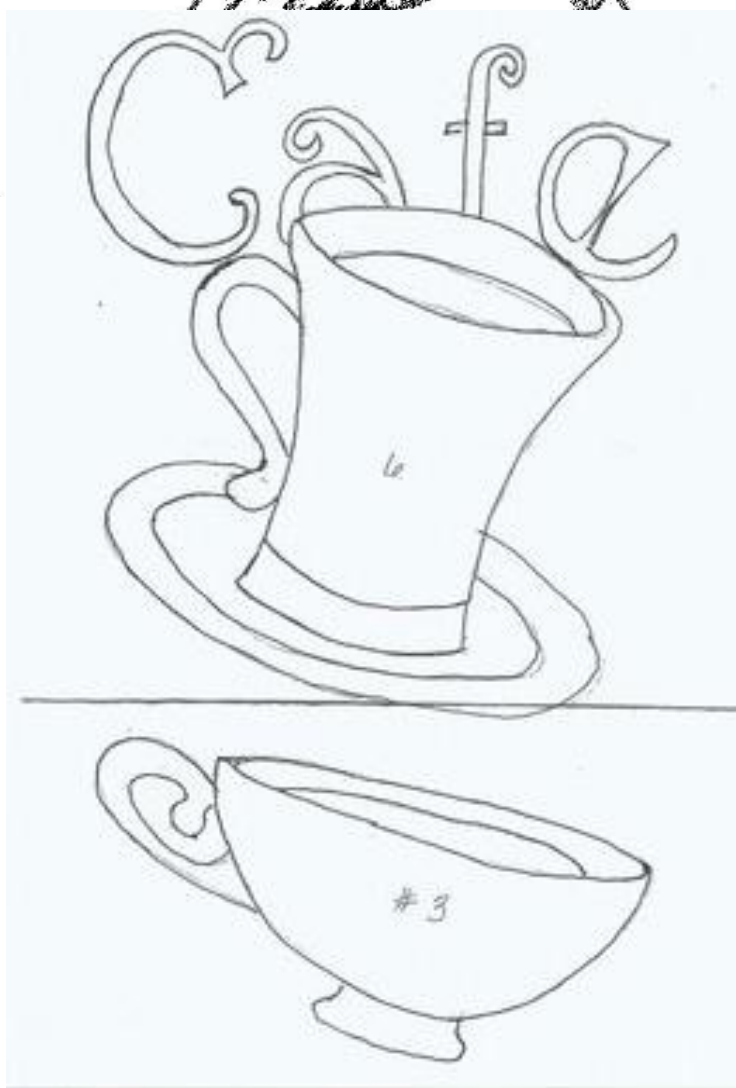
Christmas Geese –Ralph & Ruby - Taught by Helen Belsey - November 9, 2015

Supplies: Delta Colour Float & jar. Brushes: Mop, 4-6-8-10 flats and fine liner

Palette: Delta – Light Ivory, Golden Brown, Seminole Green, Red Iron Oxide, Dolphin Grey, Opaque Red, Straw, Burnt Umber, Black, Apple Green, White, and Chocolate Cherry.

Home Preparation: Choose your own surface & background colour. Base in background. Trace on basic design – omit ribbon and holly. Basing is solid: Geese body – Light Ivory. Beak and feet - Golden Brown. Trace on details. Base: Holly – Seminole Green. Ribbon – Red Iron Oxide

COFFEE CUPS –

TAUGHT BY SHARON

STAFFORD – OCTOBER 5<sup>TH</sup>, 2015

*You get to be creative & suit your own colour preferences with this one. Pick a background colour that you'd like & pair it up with coordinating colours for the cups. The following are some of the colour's I've used.*

- Surface: your choice. I've done them on a tray, 8x8 canvases.....
- You can do 2 cups or if you want a 3<sup>rd</sup> just reverse the pattern to have the cup facing the other direction
- *You'll need to pick **one colour** for the **background*** Asphaltum (or any dark brown), or Camel, or French Grey Blue, or...your choice.
- Pair it with a **coordinating colour** for the **base colour of the cups** such as Camel, or Jade, or Sand, or Red Iron Oxide ... or your choice.
- Pick a **coordinating colour to stencil on a design** on the cup
- Bring a stencil that will fit on the cup to stencil on a design. I've used small parts of a larger stencil.
- Optional: Stencil on a design in the background.
- Other colours you'll need to bring are: **shade colour** for the cups (I've used Asphaltum on all those cup colours or bring your choice of shade colour), A **highlight colour for the cups** (I used Warm White on everything).
- **Prework:** Base the background & cups and words (I used Sand for the words).
